Guidelines for abstract and final paper submission:

- The abstract should not be more than 250 words
- The complete paper should be generally NOT longer than 10 pages
- Please use MS Word document format (.doc) or RTF (Rich Text Format)
Preferred format for abstracts and papers: A4 paper; 1" margin all round; single-spaced; Times New Roman Font size 12
- All papers are to be written using the APA publication guidelines:
 1. In-text citations giving author, year, and sometimes page number in the body of the paper
 2. A reference list at the end of the paper providing complete details of each in-text citation
- Please submit using e-mail attachment

Notification of Acceptance of Abstracts	04 September 2010
Deadline for Submission of Full Papers	30 September 2010
